Recognizing dairy leaders of today

We also recognize achievements by contemporary leaders. The top recipient, the "Guest of Honor," receives kudos at the annual National Dairy Shrine banquet, along with an outstanding active dairy cattle breeder.

Inspiring future dairy leaders

Some of our most exciting awards are the more than \$35,000 in scholarships and grants given each year to dairy students. These include:

- **Kildee Scholarships** – Participants in the national collegiate or 4-H dairy judging contests and dairy challenge can apply for two \$3,000 scholarships for graduate work or one \$2,000 scholarship for undergraduate study
- **DMI Milk Marketing Scholarships** – Up to \$1,500 for college students interested in careers in milk marketing
- **Student Recognition Contest** – Cash awards to encourage college seniors to work with dairy cattle after graduation
- **McCullough Scholarships** – \$2,500 and \$1,000 scholarships for incoming college freshmen who plan to pursue dairy communication careers



- **Progressive Dairy Producer Award** – Two \$2,000 educational travel awards for successful young dairy producers
- **Graduate Production Award** – A \$2,500 grant for purchased cattle for a young dairy producer

- **Core Scholarship** – For freshmen majoring in dairy/animal science
- **Iager Scholarships** – Awards for dairy students at two-year agricultural schools
- **Klussendorf Scholarship** – Outstanding animal or dairy science students may apply
